As you may know, USA Rugby changed the name of the U20 WNT to Women Junior All-Americans (WJAA) over the fall season. I am in need of your assistance to identify the girls who should be representing their country. We have an open application process for the regional camps in March. You can nominate your own players or one that you have seen. Players can even nominate themselves for the camp.

The regional camps are located in different areas on different weekends so the players can choose what is best for them. The regional camps will be the first development opportunity and selection process the WJAA's participation in the U20 Women's Nation's Cup in England July 8-21, 2013.

Players must be born on or after September 1, 1992.

There will be 4 regional camps in March that will be a selection vehicle for the WJAA team. Players must attend one of the camps: one that is convenient in time, cost, and travel. If you are interested or know an interested player, please click the link on the left and fill out the application.

There are 2 physical tests that will be part of the qualifying procedures. If you have questions regarding the tests, please visit Eagle 365. To go to this site click the link on the left.

The regional camps will be:

March 1-3 Atlanta, GA
March 8-10 Fullerton, CA
March 15-17 Portland, OR
March 23-24 Herndon, VA

The nominations are due by February 15, 2013, but I would recommend submitting them as soon as possible to secure a spot at the regional camps. The results of the physical testing are required. I would recommend submitting the application by January 31 to get a spot at the camp of preference.
